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OBJECTIVE:

The **Integration Youth Services Society (IYSS)** is a non-profit society registered in the Province of British Columbia serving young people and their families in City of Richmond and Greater Vancouver. Our approach is to facilitate self-help through providing integrated and holistic services in the areas of education, personal growth, community outreach, and cultural and recreational activities.

VISION OF IYSS:

We believe every young person is capable of becoming a leader in his/her respective role in society, providing that he/she:

- i. learns about oneself (self-awareness) and accepts oneself (self-acceptance)
We hope to facilitate young people's personal growth and to walk with them.
- ii. improves communication skills to facilitate mutual understanding
We hope to bridge the communication gap between young people and their families
- iii. discovers ones' potentials and maximizes them
We hope to stimulate young people to search for their meanings and directions in life.

HISTORY:

The history of IYSS can be traced back to the year 1999, when Esther Ho, founder of IYSS, started *Mustard Seed Education Path (MSEP)*, a proprietorship to provide academic, hobbies, music, personal and family growth courses and activities to families, children and youth in the City of Richmond. This experience made her aware of the depth of the needs of new immigrant families and the lack of effective programs facilitating settlement and smooth integration into a new culture. In 2001, Esther started putting together a group of people sharing similar goals and passion and in March 2002, IYSS was founded and registered as a non-profit society. IYSS inherited and expanded the Mustard Seed Children Theatre, Youth Band, Spring Break and Summer Day Camp, and Self-development courses—programs with proven success during the early days run under the auspices of MSEP.

From the beginning, IYSS believes in the importance of an integrated approach to youth work. We work directly with young people to help them build a good value system, self-esteem and commit to personal growth. We work with children to offer the early positive formation equipping them with skills growing up in a diverse culture. We also work closely with parents knowing that a lot of the challenges young people face are rooted or related to inter-generational relations.

Since 2002, IYSS have successful launched many programs reaching over 9,000 people in the short history of the Society. In 2006 alone, more than 4800 people, mostly residents of Richmond participated in the various programs of IYSS. Some of the our best known and most popular programs include: Parent Support Group, Children Integrated Arts Summer Camp, Mustard Seed Adult and Children Theatres, Youth Book Research Project and Personal Growth Youth Pilgrimage to Yunnan, China (a partnership with Vancouver Sowers Society of Education).

LOOKING FORWARD:

IYSS takes pride in our success of being a grassroots' organization working on a shoestring budget over the past 5 years while serving close to 10,000 people. To build on our success, we believe that it is now time to have proper funding for our very dedicated staff and volunteers. Proper funding will also ensure better accessibility for more people as most of our past programs are fee-based aims to recover costs ran by volunteers. Looking ahead, we are working towards finding a permanent home for a Youth Centre some time within the next 3 years. We believe that we will not be able to continue to improve and expand our services without the support from the governments.

往年的聖誕和除夕，總會和一大班朋友狂歡慶祝渡過。剛過去的平安夜，沒有了聖誕大餐，沒有了聖誕燈飾，沒有了聖誕樹；剛渡過的除夕，沒有了煙花，沒有了倒數，沒有了歡呼。可是，我卻一點可惜也沒有，反而覺得是我過得最開心、最難忘、及最有意義的聖誕假期。

還記得07年初，在報紙上看到有關“助我成長2006”的報導，已覺得這是一個很有意義的活動。真興幸當初能夠立下決心參與，否則今天必定會後悔不已。這一年裡，身為籌委會成員的我，看著由當初對這個計劃無從入手，慢慢發展到現在順利完滿舉行，那份喜悅及滿足感是前所未有的。由設計、宣傳、招募、籌款、以至成行，整個過程裡學習到很多東西；而當中的哀與樂、悲與喜，亦能為我帶來很多回憶。不過，最可惜的是有些籌委會的成員未能同行，不然這個旅程將會更加完美。

籌備多時的旅程終於要實現了！出發的時刻，我的心情是期待的、興奮的，就像第一天上學的心情一樣。出發前，其實我對雲南的認識實在不多，就連它地理上的正確位置亦不清楚，只知道它是一個比較窮困的省份。初次踏足彩雲之南，它給我的印象跟我原先想像的，沒有太大差別，到處也充滿著濃厚的鄉村氣息；初次接觸當地的人，亦同樣覺得他們跟原先所想的分別不大。可是，跟那裡的農民及學生相處了短短的幾天之後，漸漸便發覺他們跟大城市裡的人真的很不同。他們雖窮，但卻比大城市的人更加待人以誠、和藹可親、刻苦耐勞、及團結一致。雖然我們在外國長大和接受教育，所見所聞可能比他們多，但是從他們身上能夠學到的東西，卻多不勝數。他們較我們更有紀律，求知欲亦比我們強。不過更重要的是，他們較我們更加知足及更加懂得珍惜。樂天知命的他們，從不埋怨沒有甚麼、生活有多艱苦，反而為他們擁有的東西感到快樂、滿足。他們雖窮，但心中卻要比我們許多人還要富有。

去到危校探訪那天，看見小朋友都擠在一間那麼狹小及簡陋的課室上課，心裡真的有點兒不好過。他們在那麼惡劣的環境下仍能努力不懈地學習，這種精神實在值得加許。相比之下，我們的學習條件優越那麼多，但仍不時挑剔這、挑剔那，沒有專心學習，看來是時候要自我檢討一下。透過家訪和入住農家，我們了解到當地人的家庭、生活、風俗、及文化，都跟我們有很大的分別。雖然他們的生活環境並不理想，但是對於我們的到訪，他們卻沒有一點吝嗇，反而將最好的東西全都獻給我們。原來，真正富有的人，是那些能夠將自己僅有的財富也分予別人的人。

這短短的十天裡，可說是我一生中最精彩、最難忘的旅程。除了感受到一種從來沒有見過、想過、體會過的生活之外，這次旅程還能讓我重新認識自己。回到自己的生活裡，感覺到自己的價值觀好像重新定位了。另一方面，我也開始積極思考一些問題，對某些事物也有了新的啟發。總括而言，這次旅程給我的得著比起我所付出的，要多很多很多。下一步需要做的，是怎樣將這個活動延續下去。下一次，我們應該如何給予更多，用何種形式幫助他們更多呢？

當我跟朋友說我會去雲南體會農村生活，他們都對我說：『要去那麼落後的地方？那裏一定很髒。』他們說得對。我們探訪的玉碗鎮是比較落後和貧困。他們所要面對的困難可能是很多生活在富有的地方的人永遠都感受不到的。

第一天，我們到達昭通市，玉碗鎮的玉碗中學，很多村民都來到街上歡迎我們。我們還未下車就已聽到學生們在校園內邊鼓掌，邊呼叫着：『歡迎，歡迎，熱烈歡迎！』他們原來已整齊地排在校園的樓梯好幾個鐘等待我們，因為我們的航機延遲到達。對於這份熱情，我非常感動，內心覺得不好意思，因為那時那裏的天氣非常寒冷及潮濕，相信他們一定很冷。

在玉碗鎮的幾天，我們參觀過三間學校。雖然三間學校的班級及制度不同，但有一共通點是學生對學習的熱誠。我們觀察過他們上課，也有跟他們交談過。他們上課都很留心，也很踴躍回答老師的問題。當我跟他們交談時，他們都很努力地用英語跟我溝通。他們很想學多一些英語，也想知道在外國生活是怎樣的。

最令我印象深刻的是在農家探訪，體會到他們日常生活真是很樸素。他們家裏只有幾張木櫬，一張木枱，及一個炭暖爐。他們都很喜歡圍在暖爐邊，一邊取暖，一邊談笑，真的非常溫馨。有時候，他們的鄰居也過來一起聊天。他們的家庭觀念比我們西方國家的人為重。家人的關係很密切。我們在西方國家生活很多時只在吃飯的時候才坐在一起。吃過飯後就各自做自己的事。我在想，我們雖然擁有很多方便聯絡的科技，但總是覺得人與人之間的距離越來越大。

我覺得那裏的人生活得很開心。沿途探訪農家，看見很多小朋友在街上玩耍。玩的都是很簡單的遊戲，例如彈波子，爬樹，或拍氣球。這麼簡單的遊戲他們都可以玩得這樣開心。但是若要富有國家的小朋友來玩這些遊戲，他們會玩得如此開心嗎？

跟一個初中的女同學傾談過，她說雖然她的家庭是貧窮，但她和家人生活得很開心。她說她很喜歡農田工作，覺得一点都不辛苦。她知道她父母做工很艱苦，很希望可以幫助她的父母。

我覺得這些學生都很成熟，也很知足。他們擁有物質不多，但他們擁有的是家庭的溫暖和發自內心的快樂。這雲南之旅令我深深體會到人怎樣在貧困的環境下生活得開心。我學會了知足常樂的道理，更瞭解到生活在比較富裕的國家並不是必然的。
